

**IMPORTANT — RULE CLARIFICATION:** When the numbers 7, 8 and/or 11 are found in THE SECOND COLUMN of a player card, they are NOT SUBJECT TO NORMAL PITCHERS' GRADE CHANGES. For example, a SECOND-COLUMN 8 on the "BASES EMPTY" board is always a "SINGLE" to left center," NO MATTER WHAT THE PITCHER'S GRADE IS.

The following players are contained in the APBA baseball card set representing the 1932 season. The batting orders may be arranged in any number of sequences without affecting the individual performances of any of the players. These were the batting orders most frequently used that year:
