

BASEBALL FAN:

The following players make up the 1985 edition of cards for the APBA Major League Baseball Game. The batting orders may be arranged in any number of sequences without affecting individual performances of any of the players. These were the batting orders most frequently used in 1984:

NATIONAL LEAGUE

1984 season

Table listing players for the National League Eastern and Western Divisions, including teams like Chicago, Montreal, New York, Atlanta, Cincinnati, Houston, Philadelphia, Pittsburgh, St. Louis, Los Angeles, and San Diego.

AMERICAN LEAGUE

Table listing players for the American League Eastern and Western Divisions, including teams like Baltimore, Boston, Cleveland, California, Chicago, Kansas City, Detroit, Milwaukee, New York, Minnesota, Oakland, and Seattle.

\*Used primarily or exclusively as a relief pitcher. Should seldom be used as a starter. (Pitchers with asterisks following their grades on the player cards themselves should be used exclusively in relief, unless they have separate starting and relieving grades.) For most realistic results the frequency of use of starting pitchers should be determined by the order of their listings above, not by the grade ratings on their cards. In the American League, any player may be used as a designated hitter, not just those listed as DH's on this line-up sheet. Play result number 42 on any player card indicates a hit batter. Runners advance one base if forced. An asterisk(\*) following a play result number on the player card means the player steals the next base (if it's unoccupied) immediately after reaching base when that result number comes up.

IMPORTANT—RULE CLARIFICATION: When the numbers 7, 8 and/or 11 are found in THE SECOND COLUMN of a player card, they are NOT SUBJECT TO NORMAL PITCHERS' GRADE CHANGES. For example, a SECOND-COLUMN 8 on the "BASES EMPTY" board is always a "SINGLE to left center" NO MATTER WHAT THE PITCHER'S GRADE IS.

Please do not write to inquire about the new year's cards unless you have not received the notice of their availability by February 1st of the new year, and please do not remit your order for new cards before you have received the new card notice giving the details for ordering.
